• There are both hot and cold deserts. Antarctica is the largest desert in the world, while the Sahara in Africa is the largest of the hot deserts. There are also deserts close to Santa Barbara, North America, Southern Asian realm, South and Central America, Ethiopia, Australia.



• Weather is not the same in all deserts. The seasons in hot and dry deserts are usually very hot during the summer and warm during the rest of the year. During winter these deserts get little rainfall. Rain is often light, or in short concentrated bursts.



• Desert plants are cacti creosote bush, sagebrush, and ocotillo.



 Some animals that live in the hot desert are coldblooded, like snakes, insects, and lizards.
Mammals that live in the desert are usually small, such as the kangaroo rat and kit fox.
