# WHERE IS THE SAVANNA?

- The savannas cover half the surface of Africa, large areas of Australia, South America and India.





# THE CLIMATE

- The climate is usually warm and the temperatures, range from 68° to 86°.
- In the savanna climate there is a distinct dry season, which is in the winter.



# THE PLANTS

- The savanna is dominated by grasses such as Rhodes grass, red oats grass, star grass, lemon grass and some shrubs. Umbrella Thorn Acacia is one of the most recognizable trees of the African savanna. It grows in sand dunes and rocky grounds of Africa's grasslands.

- Animals native to African savannas include African elephants, zebras, horses and jiraffes.
