Location

- The tundra biome is the coldest of all biomes. Tundra biome is located in the arctic circle



Weather

- The tundra is the coldest and the driest of all the biomes on Earth. . Winters here are long, and summers short, sometimes they last for only 6 - 10 weeks. In the winter the temperature can reach -50°F (-45.5°C).

Plants

- Don't think that plants would never live or survive in this biome. Tundra plants get their energy from the sun through photosynthesis like all other plants, but have adapted to low temperatures and low light intensities.
- More of plants are: The Calliergon giganteum, the Salix Arctica, Labrador tea and amazing arctic moos.
